The Help Room is located in 178 Heady Hall. The Help Room is open in the Fall and Spring semesters, typically from 9 AM-5 PM Monday through Friday. During finals week, the usual Help Room schedule may be modified to accommodate the finals of both teaching assistants (TAs) and students. The Help Room has a supervisor, and is staffed by on-duty TAs.

Purposes

- The Help Room's main purpose is to help students taking ECON 1010, 1010L, 1020, 1030X, 2070, 3010, 3020, and 3710 outside of the regular office hours scheduled for those courses.
- The Help Room will also help students taking other undergraduate economics courses outside of the regular office hours scheduled for such courses.
- Upon request to the Help Room supervisor by a course instructor, students in that course can submit and/or pick up homework and exams at the Help Room.
- The Help Room can be used to proctor exams for individual students who cannot take tests at the regularly scheduled times for their courses.
- Upon request to the Help Room supervisor by a course instructor, the Help Room will provide TAs to proctor exams at regularly scheduled times for that course.
