Abstract:	<p>The Sloan Research Fellowships seek to stimulate fundamental research by early-career scientists and scholars of outstanding promise.</p> <p>Candidates must hold a Ph.D. (or equivalent) in chemistry, computational or evolutionary molecular biology, computer science, economics, mathematics, neuroscience, ocean sciences, physics, or a related field. They must hold a tenure track (or equivalent) position at a college, university, or other degree-granting institution in the United States. Tenure track faculty positions at the candidate's institution must include a yearly teaching requirement.</p> <p>Candidates' most recent Ph.D. must have been awarded on or after September 1, 2011 (Some exceptions may apply. See eligibility details at the link above.)</p>

Additional Criteria:

- While Fellows are expected to be at an early stage of their research careers, there should be **strong evidence of independent research accomplishments**.
- Nominees may have an appointment in any department. However, they must be **doing basic research in one of the eight Ph.D. fields** listed above.
- Sloan Fellows demonstrate qualifications that identify them as rising stars and the next generation of scientific leaders.
- Candidates in all fields are normally below the rank of associate professor and do not hold tenure, but these are not strict requirements.

Funding:

Awards are \$65,000 in flexible research support.

Internal Nomination Procedure:

- Candidates must be nominated by a department head or other senior researcher; **however, no more than three candidates may be nominated from any one department**.
- Please prepare and submit the following:
 - a 1-page research summary describing current and future work and
 - CV, no more than 4 pages.Please provide one PDF document using your last name in the file name.
- **Deadline:** Required information should be uploaded to the link below by **5:00 on August 1, 2017**.
